



Student Uniform Policy



The school uniform is an important part of Carmel School's culture. It reflects the values we place on being a Modern Orthodox Jewish Day School and our standards of excellence. Students are expected to wear their uniform in a way as that demonstrates pride in being identified with Carmel School. The full and appropriate uniform must be worn by students at all times when representing the School. This includes attending inter-school functions or designated internal school functions such as Speech Night, Valedictory and ANZAC assemblies.

Please note that for Years 10 to 12 students, this includes a Carmel School blazer. Students in Year 10 to 12 must have a blazer available and wear it to all official school functions. Students in Years 10 to 12 are strongly encouraged to wear a blazer at School during Terms 2 and 3.

Students and parents should be aware that the appearance of the uniform depends to a large extent upon how it is worn – its cleanliness, its fit and its state of repair. All students are expected to be well groomed, neat and tidy.

- Shirts should be tucked in.
- Shorts, trousers, skirts and dresses should be touching the knee when standing
- Shoes should be polished

It is impossible to provide a complete list of acceptable / unacceptable dress requirements and presentation. However, at the discretion of staff, any student whose standard of presentation does not meet expectations will be asked to rectify their dress.

Seasons

Summer Uniform is to be worn in Terms 1 and 4

Winter uniform is to be worn in Terms 2 and 3.

If there is any day that is unseasonably hot/cold, notification will be given by the Head of School (Primary or Secondary) if the other uniform may be worn for that day.

Hair

'Novelty' haircuts, such as mullets or undercuts, are not permitted. In matters of hairstyle, the School remains the final arbiter and students may be directed to restyle hair if necessary.

Boys should be clean shaven. Exceptions are made on religious grounds during periods of national Jewish mourning.

Jewellery and Make Up

Students are permitted to wear the items listed below. No responsibility can be accepted for the loss or damage to any personal items that a student brings or wears to school:

- One plain stud or sleeper (maximum 10mm outside diameter) is permitted in the lower ear lobe. No other piercings are to be displayed. Taping over a piercing is not permitted
- We encourage the wearing of an inexpensive, serviceable wrist watch. (If students choose to wear a smartwatch, which is not recommended, it must be on airplane mode while at school)
- Religious necklaces can be worn, but must not be visible
- No noticeable make-up or coloured nail polish is to be worn

Footwear

- Students in Primary School are permitted to wear navy sandals during the summer terms. In winter terms black leather school shoes must be worn
- Students in High school must wear black leather, lace up school shoes. Black runners are not acceptable
- For days on which students have Sport or HPE, students can wear sneakers. Please ensure the sneakers have a non-marking sole

School Bag

- For security reasons, students are required to have a clearly labelled Carmel School bag.
