

PRINCIPAL'S SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION
Open to Students Entering Years 5–12 in 2027

The Principal's Scholarship *may* be awarded at the discretion of the Principal to one or more students each Year. The recipient may or may not be a current student of the School. Applicants must be of good character and demonstrate the capacity to make a meaningful contribution to Carmel School and the wider community. The scholarship recognises a student who embodies the School's values of excellence, integrity, connectedness, curiosity and courage. Importantly the recipient must be able to positively influence others.

Applicants should focus on a range of factors, including **but not limited to**, positive academic achievement, co-curricular involvement, personal qualities and community engagement.

The scholarship provides a partial remission of tuition fees of up to 50% per year and is reviewed annually. The duration of the scholarship will be determined by the Principal.

The recipient is expected to demonstrate an ongoing commitment to; their studies, the betterment of the school environment, the service of others and the positive representation of Carmel School in the community as an excellent ambassador for the School. Complying with Carmel School's policies and values, the recipient must demonstrate the highest personal and professional standards, be a Mensch (a person of high integrity, honour, and rectitude) and actively participate in School life. The scholarship may be withdrawn at any time if the above expectations are not being met.

A completed copy of this form in PDF format, including the student's handwritten answers and scanned copies of:

1. The most recent school report.
2. The most recent NAPLAN results.
3. Details of the most recent merit-based achievements: arts, sport, charity, community, etc.
4. Two external written references (Jewish or non-Jewish) to support your child's application. Referees must not be family members or Carmel School staff.
5. A handwritten 1-page letter by the student outlining their motivation for applying, and what this scholarship would mean to them.

If you do not have copies of the school report or NAPLAN results, please contact your current school. If unavailable, the school can request them from the relevant State or Territory test administration authority.
